The Project Executing Agency now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for Tender No.EEP/PP/IFB/01/2021 on Procurement of Plant Design, Supply. and construction, test and Commissioning of two (2) substation extensions and three (3) new Substations and 230kV and 132kV Transmission Lines Southern Extension of the National Electricity Grid Power Transmission Project
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through Competitive Bidding (CB) procedures specified in the Guideline for Procurement under EDCF Loan, and is open to all eligible bidders that meet the as defined in the procurement guidelines. The bidder shall be limited to those firms who are entitled eligible by the Article 4.2 through 4.5 of the Instruction to Bidders in Section of the bidding document, and the Section III, which provides the qualification criteria of the Bidders.

This Invitation for Bids is open to only bidders from the Republic of Korea as defined in the Loan Agreement. A Bidder shall be deemed to have the nationality of the Republic of Korea if the Bidder is a national or is constituted, incorporated, or registered and operates in conformity with the provisions of the laws of that country

- Bidders must have experience under construction contracts in the role of contractor, subcontractor, equipment manufacturer or management contractor for at least the last Ten (10) years prior to the submission deadline.
- Participation as contractor, management contractor, or subcontractor, equipment manufacturer in at least two (2) contracts for overhead transmission lines and two(2) contracts for substations of 230kV and/or above within the last ten (10) years up to the submission, with values of not less than Thirty million US Dollars (30 million US Dollars) each.
- The sum of route length of overhead transmission line contract(s) of 230kV and/or above should not be less than fifly (130) km, and at least one(1) contract having 400kV and/or above line bays, transformer, transformer bays have been successfully completed on turnkey basis within the last ten (10) years up to submission
- At least onc(1) Overhead transmission line and one(1) substation contracts in
 the above have been implemented outside of bidder's country Submission of
 audited balance sheets and income statements or, if not required by law of
 the Bidder's country, other financial statements acceptable to the Employer,
 for the last five(5) years to demonstrate the current soundness of the Bidder's
 financial position and its prospective long-term profitability. As a minimum, a
 Bidder's net worth calculated as the difference between total assets and total
 liabilities should be positive
- The average annual tumover and the cash-flow requirement forthe Bidder's organization or Joint Venture, Consortium or Association shall not less than the following
- 1. average annual turnover USS 85million with the last five (5) years.
- * The partner in charge in case of JV, Consortium, or association shall meet not less than 40% and each partner shall meet not less than 25% of this minimum criteria n. Cash-flow requirement: USS 25million.
- * The partner in charge in case of JV, Consortium, or association shall meet not less than 40% and each partner shall meet not less than 25% of this minimum criteria.
